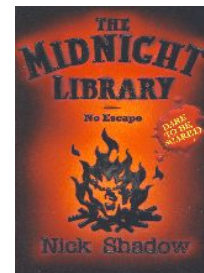
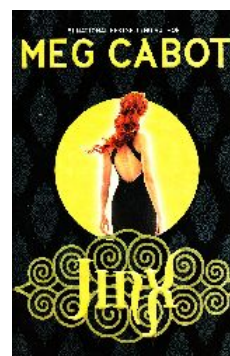
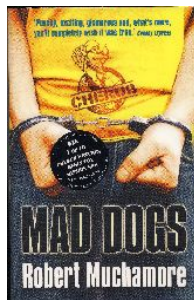

Free Online Tutoring!

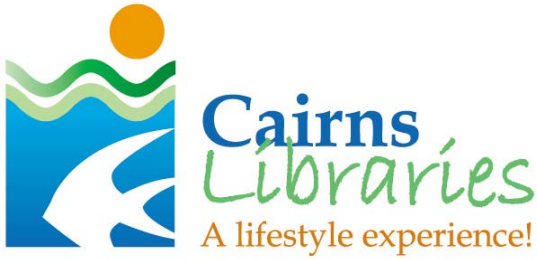
